Application for Extension of Study for the MPS Students in Applied Statistics

The MPS Program in Applied Statistics at Cornell University is a one-year program. Under special circumstances, before the end of the first year (or before the end of the original study plan) a student may formally request an extension of his/her study. This request must be approved by the MPS program before the student takes any further action. Legitimate reasons for such an extension may be health-related problems, valid academic need(s) and other uncontrollable factors that prevent a student from finishing his/her MPS degree in one year (or with the original study plan). A student who is granted an extension of study must pay the full tuition and maintain a full-time status during the extension period(s). However, if such an approved student completes all the MPS degree requirements before the extension period starts, the student still has to graduate at the time when all the MPS degree requirements are met and the previously approved extension of study becomes void.
